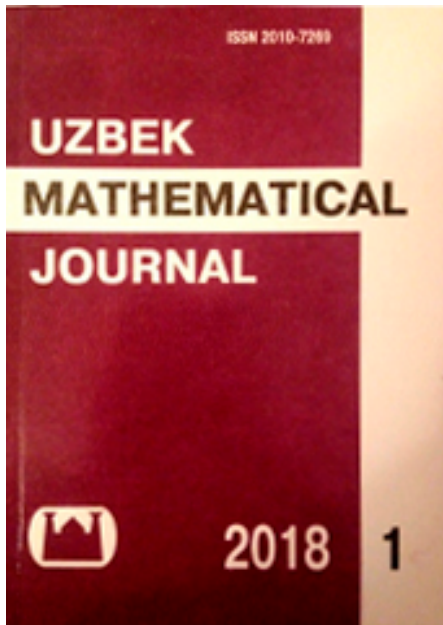


“Uzbek Mathematical Journal”
