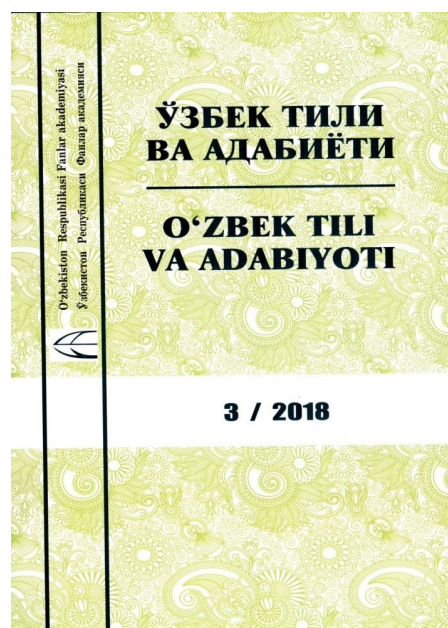


# Uzbek language and literature
